

ANESTHESIA for HOSPITAL PATIENTS

The fee for anesthetic services provided for the removal of impacted wisdom teeth by an oral surgeon was eliminated as a benefit under the Ontario Health Insurance Plan (OHIP)

It is now the responsibility of the patient to pay the anesthetic fee in full. An insurance form will be completed for you and the claim will be made payable to the insured for reimbursement.

The anesthetic fee for the removal of third molars is \$400.00. The **full amount of \$400.00** is paid to our office before the surgery. Our office accepts Visa, M/C, Debit and cash.

If you do not have any form of insurance, a receipt for

income tax purposes will be issued.
